Match Play Format & Rules

- USGA rules for match play apply.
- No handicaps will be used for individual matches.
- The player with the **lowest score on a hole wins** that hole.
- The match ends when a player is up by more holes than remain.

- The player farthest from the hole plays first until holed out.
- You may **concede a stroke**, **hole**, **or match** at any time (e.g., a 'gimme' putt).
- If the match is **tied after 18 holes**, continue playing sudden-death until one player wins a hole. Check with the clubhouse to confirm which holes are available for extra play.
- Local course rules apply; see each course's scorecard for details.
- Matches should be played as a twosome, unless another twosome (also playing their tournament match) joins. Only players in the Season-Long Match Play may be in the group.
- This is a double elimination format:
 - o After your **first loss**, you move to the **Consolation Bracket**.
 - After your **second loss**, you are eliminated from the tournament.

Scheduling Matches

- Use the KWGA Golf Software app at kwga.golfclub.net to view player contact info (phone and email).
- Select the appropriate round (e.g., Season-Long Match Play Round 1 Indian Run) and click **Details**, then **Player List**.
- Find your opponent and contact them to schedule your match at your earliest convenience.
 - Tip: Don't wait until the end of the month early match completions allow us to open the next round sooner!
- Contact the course to book your tee time. Mention "KWGA Season-Long Match Play" to receive the special rate.
- Pay at the course pro shop on the day of your match.

Scoring & Reporting Results

- Use the course scorecard to track your match including holes won and lost.
- After the match, email a photo of both players and the result to:

- Watch your email for next-round pairings and course information.

 Tee times will be announced.
- If you cannot attend the final day, contact the tournament directors immediately to make alternate arrangements.
- (Optional) Non-finalists are encouraged to come play a round, cheer on the finalists, and join in the fun!

An RSVP form will be sent out after Round 3.

Winners will be recognized and prizes awarded at the KWGA Annual Meeting on September 22, 2025 at The Prairies.
