Our New Software Has Launched!!

The goal of this news bulletin is to help all the members understand our new software and get familiar with it before our first tournament. I can already hear many of you sigh – another app I need to download 😞. Well, here is the first GREAT news – you won't have to download a new app.

Let's first start with WHY? Why did we switch software. The previous software was a great way to switch from paper to electronic. There are many systems out there all claiming to be better, smarter, easier, etc. Our current software could not keep up with many of the changes, especially the integration with GHIN. We have also found it lacking in keeping course ratings updated. While the feature of having a handicap app was very useful, it needed an admin person to add courses, and we could not predict all the courses you might want to play. So, the first thing you can do is delete the GolfSoftware App, as we will no longer be using it (don't delete it if you use it for a different league).

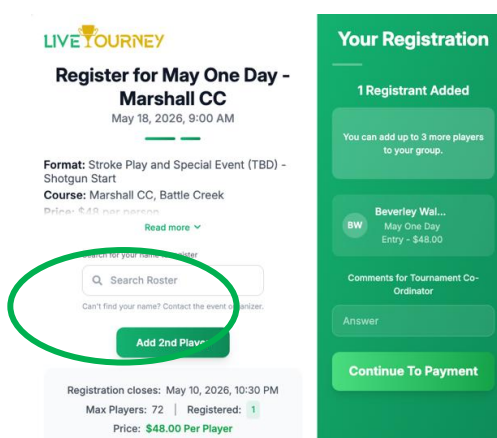
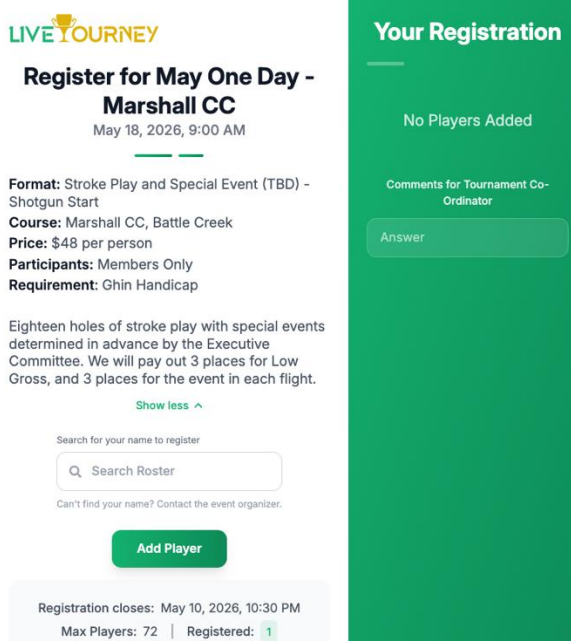
How to Sign up for Events

KWGA Events Page

Go to the same place you always went to sign up for events. This is where the first bit of magic happens. When you sign up now, you are signing up directly into the software. You don't need to wait for us to add you to a different software – it's live. This will also eliminate any double registration for the same event. On the events page, click on any tournament to get more details about the event. We have tried to include info on pricing, format, the course, and who can participate. If it shows Members Only, you will only be able to sign up if you are in our Roster (another new feature our previous software could not do). Just start typing your name in the Search Roster field and you will come up. You won't have to add emails, handicaps or other information, unless you are signing up a guest.

All our One Day Events will now allow you to sign up as a team or individually. If you sign up your team, you can see your team together in one place. If you sign up individually, some manual intervention is needed, so you won't see yourself in your team until that has happened (please don't expect that to happen immediately). Actual hole assignments will only happen once the event has closed. The last info on signing up for events is that you can now see who is signed up for an event. At the bottom of the registration details page, you will see Registered #. If you click on the number, you will see everyone that is registered for that event. Now you don't have to guess which of your friends have already signed up. You will even see their comments, so if they are looking for someone to play with, you will see that too.

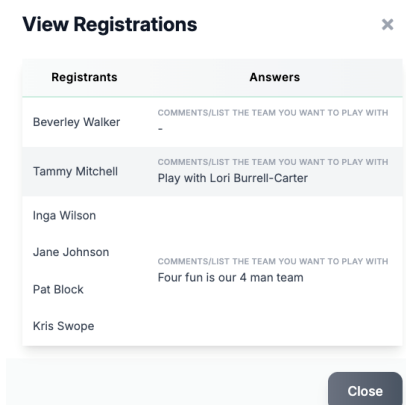
A snap shot of what an event looks like on the sign up page. You may have to select [Read more](#) to see all the details.

Rather than downloading an app to your phone, Live Tourney's leaderboards are accessible through a mobile browser. The leaderboard can be accessed in the following manor:

- **QR Code:** The printed scorecards will have a QR Code, you will be able to scan the QR code to access the event.
- **Website:** The same place where you sign up, when the event is live it will let you access the scorecard with the Code listed on your scorecard (note these codes are unique to every scorecard).

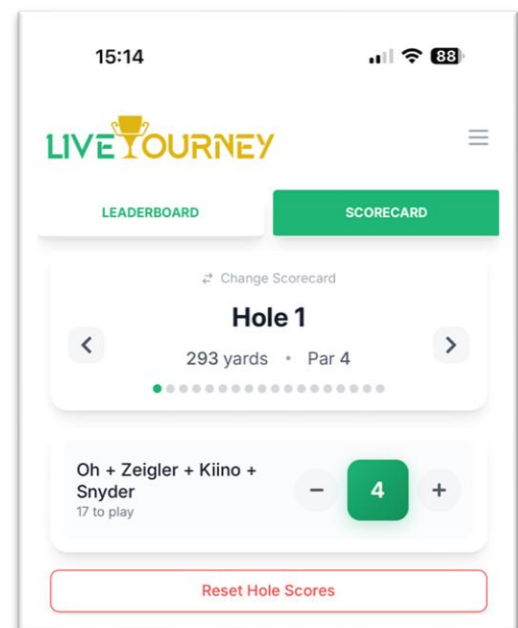
So, the key to getting ready to use this software is know how to scan a QR code with your phone. Most people probably already know how to do this, but here are some general guidelines that may help you. There will be help available at the events to get you started.

How to Scan a QR Code on iPhone (iOS)

- **Open Camera:** Open the Camera app from the Home Screen, Control Center, or Lock Screen.
- **Scan:** Select the rear-facing camera, hold it steadily, and point it at the QR code.
- **Tap Link:** Tap the notification or link that appears on the screen.
- **Alternative:** You can use the "Scan Code" button in the Control Center.

How to Scan a QR Code on Android

- **Open Camera:** Open your default camera app.
- **Point:** Point the camera at the QR code.
- **Tap Link:** Tap the banner or link that appears.
- **Alternative (via Assistant):** Use the Quick Settings menu to select the "QR scanner" option.



This is what the scorecard looks like on your phone, very easy and clean interface to use.

If you don't like scanning QR Codes, you can save the [KWGA Events Page](#), either in your bookmarks, or as a Quick Access "App Icon" (Without Installing an App):

- **Safari (Apple Users):**
 1. Open Safari and go to the event webpage.
 2. Tap the Share button (square with an up arrow).
 3. Scroll and tap "Add to Home Screen."
 4. Edit the name if desired, then tap "Add."
- **Chrome (Android Users):**
 1. Open Chrome and load the event webpage.
 2. Tap the three-dot menu (top-right).
 3. Tap "Add to Home screen."

Edit the name if desired. The icon will appear on your home screen.

USGA GHIN APP!

A quick reminder that this will be the first year we will all be using the same handicap system (unless you are a guest). This also helps to ensure that everything is fair as we are using the best handicap system available. If you are new to GHIN, please ensure you create your digital profile (a link will be sent when you are added to the USGA system), and then post your scores to get your handicap. If you need your scores from last year's app, just reach out to Bev. If you don't have a handicap, you will compete as a 0 handicap, something I don't think any of us want to do.

We are so excited to get this new season started. This new software will address many of the issues raised at the annual meeting. For example, being able to see who is signed up immediately and even being able to sign up together. The electronic scoring will be easier and can even be used for match play. One thing I love is that I don't need to type in my email and phone number every time I sign up. Just selecting your name is already so much easier.

We know there will be a learning curve for all of us but together we can make this work.
